



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

In 1838, Hogenson established a 10" beech tree as

the corner. No other corner ties.

In 1880, C.E. Mitchell recovered corner established by P. Eastman. Road survey of North-South 1/4 line of Section 11 (see Mason Co. Surveyor Book 1, page 103). No references.

In 1888, Metcalf recovered corner by testimony and indicated stone at corner. No references.

In 1988, K. Ross surveyed in Section 11 (see Liber 374, page 6 in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office). The following corner references: The following corner references:
