

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration.

Original survey established in 1838 by Hogenson. Set a wooden post with the following references: Bearing tress: Hemlock 18" N58°W 18 lks.

Hemlock 10" S67°E 20 lks.

Stream 1.91 chains West 30 lks. wide.

Stream 3.0 chains South 30 lks. wide.

In 1888, W.E. Metcalf ( Deputy Co. Surveyor) set a cedar fence post by testimony (see Mason Co. Surveyor Record Book 1, page 204 in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office).

K-4 Original survey established in 1838 by Hogenson. Set a wooden post with the following references: Bearing trees: Sug. Maple 8" S40°E 25 lks. Sug. Maple 6" N65°W 10 lks.

In 1888, W.E. Metcalf (Deputy Co. Surveyor) restored corner by proportionate measurement and set a long round stoned on top of a broken stone (see Mason Co. Surveyor Record Book 1, page 20% in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office).

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1/2" dia. X 24" rerod in center line of Kinney road. Deep cut below natural surface for road at the corner. Culvert West 189 feet stream flows North. A wood fence corner bears S5°W a a distance of 34 feet. An ancient fence running South bears East a distance of 2 feet from the existing fence. A stream South 198 feet. Accepted position of the recovered rerod as the best available evidence of the perpetuated location of the original corner.

K-4 Found broken stoned flush to ground surface with a long round stone underneath. The corner located at the West end of a two-track road, not in use. Ancient fences running South and West from corner. Accepted position of stones set by Metcalf as the legal and proper reestablishment of the original corner. corner. Northeast corner of Section 11 bears Noº20'04"W a distance of 2583.14 feet. Southeast corner of Section 11 bears S0°12'00"E a distance of 2597.62
