  B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- K-13 Section Corner for Sections 35 and 36, I18N, R16W, on the township line.

On August 9, 1995, I found a 1/2" Re-Rod with a Ross Surveys P.S. cap about 100 feet South of Chauvez Road I search the area for Metcalf's Pine Stumps but found nothing to fit his distance with the given bearings, also found no other Irons or Markers or Witness trees.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- K 13Section Corner for Sections 35 and 36, T18N, R16W, on the township line.

I replaced 1/2" Re-Rod with a 5/8" Re-Rod, 24" long with an aluminum cap stamped MASON COUNTY Monument placed flush with the ground surface, and is accepted as a careful anf faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
