B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found concrete monument set by Schulke in 1990 with the four "BT's" as following:

12" Blk. Oak N48°W 10.23 ft. (location tag
4" W Pine S73°W 15.56 ft. (should be S76" W Oak S33°W 58.47 ft.
7" twin Oak N63°E 34.81 ft. (location tag) (should be S73°E)

1 and 2 are gone (#1 fails in area that was excavated by narrow gauge railroad).
#3 Measured S0°07'E 589.2 ft. in 1990 (recorded

592.7 ft. or 8.98 chains). #4 Not recovered in 1990 (in 1978 found a very

decayed pine stump).

#5 Measured West on line & found stump a distance of 698.89 ft. (recorded as 698.91 ft. or 10.59 chains). Found Nordlun & Associates Inc. capped iron S00°00'07"E a distance of 120.73 ft. from Schulke monument.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
Found fence line (ancient woven wire) along the East and North sides of NE 1/4 of Section 35.
Placed an aluminum County cap on monument to identify the corner. The following corner references:

6" W Pine S70°E 15.66 ft.

15" Blk. Oak N51°W 10.24 ft.

15" Blk. Oak 12" Twin W Oak N62°E 34.83 811 W Oak N35°W 58.46 ft.

NOTE: Corner is accepted as a careful and faithful restoration of the position of the original corner.

fragments. Fence to North runs approximately 2640 ft. to another fence corner and turns West. Found all the above line trees as White pine stumps by measuring from fence corner, in the summer of 1978. Heard verbal testimony from two people about corner Location, Eric Hoffman and Gene Myzgood. Eric stated "fences were built inside the section lines in Section 35 up to two rods to allow for future road construction". Mr. Hoffman was the son of Paul Hoffman who purchased the East half of Section 35 in 1921 Gene Myzgood showed me the location of where corner post stood ir in November of 1977 at the North side of the old fence corner. Gene was part owner of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 35. Both of these men are now deceased. Living witnesses: William Miller Sr. of Gobles, MI, Gaye Schulke of Ludington, MI and John Schulke of Ludington, MI.
