Borsfa 3/4" Iron Rod & Wood Stake, but could not find, we then check RE-Rod location from recorded witnesses we located, accepted RE-Rod as a good reestablishment position of the Re-Rod fit record distances & bearing of found trees, of J. Borsfay corner.
