On December 6, 1994, Kevin Pritchard, Jack Schulke and I search a computed location for any evidence or witnesses to the original corner, also search for old fences and other occupation, but found none.

Due to lack of any evidence of original corner we set corner using single proportional method, set half-way on line between NW corner section 25 and the NE corner section 25, computed a Grid bearing of S 89°-20'-40" E, and a split distance of 2655.68', agaist G.L.O. distance of 2643.30'

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- 1/4 Corner for Sections 24 & 25, T19N, R15W.
