I found a 12" Tent Stake inside a Monument Box, Witnesses (1), (2), (5) and (6) have been destroyed. Witnesses (3) and (4) are standing and in good condition. I could find no other evidence to dispute the location of this corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner Common to Sections 33 and 34, T.19N., R.16W.,

I replaced the 12" Tent Stake in its exact location with a 5/8" X 24" iron re-rod with a standard 3" aluminum cap stamped "Mason County Monument", inside the Monument Box in the center-line of Decker Road and about 6" below the Bituminous surface of Decker Road and accepted this corner as the best available evidence of the re-establishment of the Original Corner.
