Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: In August, 1996, I found a 1" square bolt in Monument Box, 2.8' East of the center-line of roadway. I cross pinned the existing iron. I completed a further search and found nothing to dispute the location of this corner. Witnesses (1) through (4) have been destroyed.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
