Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

October 7, 1998, James J. Keller, RLS #10693 (FB 138-4 P66) Set 1/2" rebar on line stone at SE Cor SW 1/4, SW 1/4 (15) and in line remains old fence N-S. June's double distance using SW corner & stone at (15) falls 19' E of fence N-S. Using this location, the angle W to N along old fence remains is 90°03'36". Double distance was discounted since the 1/4 Mile West of this proposed location has 3 steep slopes of nearly 1 to 1 and approaching 40' in height. In addition 2 low swampy areas were Traversed. Believe this to represent most probable location of the original corner, and the location used by Lyman W. June in 1907. Found barb in 24" Oak 100' to the West is 6" North of line E-W.
