

Corner G-8 was approved for remonumentation at a Peer Review Committee Meeting on July 22, 1997.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found bolt spike in mon box, replaced spike with 3/4" pipe and brass cap stamped Midland Co. Remon Co.
