

Corner 29 was approved for remonumentation at a Peer Review Committee Meeting on 9/23/96.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- D-9 1/4 corner common to Sections 20 and 29

Found 1/2" rod, replaced with 5/8" rod and brass cap stamped Midland Co. Remon Cor. PS 29241, per survey by J. Schafer, and LCRC by J. Schafer and T. Mueller; and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the accepted corner.
