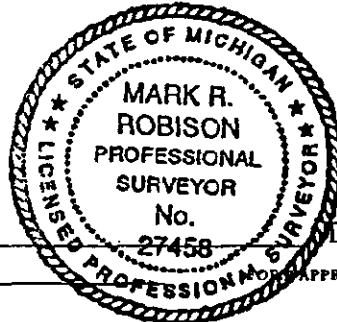
Corner M-9, T14N, R2W and A-9 T14N, R1W were approved for remonumentation at a Peer Review Committee Meeting on 9/17/99
