A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

L-7, T5S, R9E, Ash Township, Monroe County - ID No. 58 South 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 13 and 24 (Ready Road, 1/2 mile west of Berlin Road - 1/2 inch tarby over 8 inch stone) 1817 G.L.O. Surveyor Joseph Fletcher set 1/4 corner at 6 inch Hickory at corner. 1903 L.A. Howard found stone witnessed: Red maple 8 inch S.20 1/3°W. 1.06 3/4 chains, Sugar Maple 8 inch S.59°W. .84 chains. 1968, A.J. Marino notes found iron rod. 1974, Gary Stanley recorded L.C.R.C., Liber 2, Page 43, found iron pipe. Surveys by various surveyors used an iron rod. Review of Ready Road road survey revealed location of stone excavated which fit L.A. Howard survey.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

L-7 - 10/94, found 1/2 inch iron pipe at surface, dug a 18 inch X 20 inch hole found a stone 13 inches deep, removed the stone, found no post. Set a 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe in monument box to replace stone and found iron pipe and witnessed as shown below. 11/15/94, set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;

1-7 - Set 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap in monument box to replace stone and iron pipe and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and Witnesses:

South 40° West 54.40 feet to found P.K. in northwest side of 36 inch Maple

North 45° West 3.35 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod

North 35.28 feet to found P.K. nail in west side utility pole

North 5° West 35.68 feet to found capped iron pipe No.16031

South 5° East 98.40 feet to northwest corner of residence No. 3530
