10/23/1995 - G.B. Warnke crew found railroad spike being 4 inches below surface. Found 3/4" x 27" iron rod being 1.3 feet below surface. Top of rod was bent to the north-northeast and straight part of rod was 0.05 feet south of the railroad spike. Dug a 20" x 46" hole and hit a vitrified drainage tile and/or cross tile (east & west across road) being 1.6 feet north of railroad spike. No other evidence was found. It is assumed that any previous evidence was destroyed when the tile was placed. Set 1" x 36" iron pipe inside momument box to replace points. 11/28/1995 - corner was Peer Group approved.  12/5/95 - set brass remonumentation cap on previously set 1" x 36" iron pipe.
