Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-13, T7s, R7E, Ida Township, Monroe County - ID No. 58 (common to I-1, T8s, R7E)
Section Corner Common to Sections 34 & 35 (Lewis Avenue & Rauch Road - asphalt over concrete over clay)
1820, G.L.O. Surveyor, Joseph Wampler, set corner of Sections 34 & 35 - witnesses: W. Oak 28 (inch)
N.15°W. 276 (links) & W. Oak 27 (inch) N.34°E. 582 (links). 1973, Angelo J. Marino found railroad
spike per field notes. 1975 - 1976, Melvin R. Fleck found railroad spike per recorded L.C.R.C, Liber 2,
Pages 138-139; and in 1979, he used railroad spike again. 1976 to present, George B. Warnke has found
and used railroad spike based on said L.C.R.C.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I-13 - 10/3/1994, found a railroad spike 1 1/2 inches below surface. Dug a 18 inch x 30 inch hole and probed in all directions; did not find post or stone or further evidence. Set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe inside monument box replacing found railroad spike and witnessed as shown below. 11/11/1994, set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I-13 - Set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace railroad spike and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and Witnesses:

South 45° West 41.87 feet found nail/shiner in east face of electric pole

North 40° Fast 41.95 feet found nail/washer in northwest face of telephone pole

North 35° West 42.30 feet top of centerline to north end of 24 inch concrete culvert

South 70° East 131.65 feet found nail/shiner in north face of electric pole
