

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Corner is located at County Line Road (N-S) & Lynch Road (E) in tarby pavement.

8/25/99 Found 1-1/4" I.D. I. pipe at surface. Dug hole 24" diameter x 24" depth. Top section of pipe 14-15" is broken at a coupling with 12-14" bottom section with maybe an iron inside could not break apart. Found pieces of granite on west side with a brick on north & south side. Drove pipe down. Poured old nails around pipe then placed stones & bricks back in place.

99 – Glenn Richard set Lenawee County Remonumentation cap on point.

RATIFIED BY PEER GROUP, PA 345 OF 1990, MONROE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, DATE 10/12/1999, COUNTY REP. This position was not established by original government surveyors. This monument is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set ½" x 18" rebar in 1-1/4" I.D. pipe drove down about 14 inches deep with Lenawee County Remonumentation cap set inside set monument box & Witnesses:

South 85° West 14.95 feet to south edge of south post of arrow sign

West 25 feet to centerline of ditch of north & south

North 50° East 39.78 feet to found nail & shiner in southeast face of AT&T pole #299

South 45° East 46.30 feet to double head nail & shiner in southwest face of AT&T pole #300

North 20° East 89.40 feet to double head nail & remonumentation shiner in west face in 32" Sycamore
