(Whiteford Rd. - north of Whiteford Center Rd. - 2 inch tarby & 6-8 inch stone base) G.L.O. Surveyor, Joseph Wampler in 1820 set post at corner of Sections 23, 24, 25 & 26, witnessed W.Oak 40 inches South 33° West 29 links & Hickory 18 inch North 44 links. 1890, Willis Baldwin notes southwest corner of Sec. 23 as stone & no witnesses near. 1971, Case & Fleck found stone, per survey recorded in Liber 627, Page 686 & recorded to stone in L.C.R.C., Liber 1, Page 141. 1971, A.J. Marino field notes indicate no point found & set PK. 1973, G.B. Warnke found stone, per survey recorded in Liber 647, Page 692. 1975, G.B. Warmke notes small bolt over stone, per Job File No. 75-24. 1977, Case & Fleck notes found iron over stone, per survey recorded in Liber 759, Page 884. 1978, James Fish recorded L.C.R.C.,

Liber 2, Page 280, to found R.R. spike. 1980 to 1993, G.B. Warnke notes iron over stone. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

K-9 = 8/3/1994 - Found 3/4 inch x 5 inch bolt at surface. 8 inch x 8 inch hollow top stone 12 inches long and 5 inches deep. Removed gramite stone and found pieces of brick 20 to 24 inches deep under stone. May have found remains of post, but not sure, at 26 to 28 inches deep. Set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with pieces of metal and brick around bottom and broke stone and placed pieces around pipe and set monument box at surface and on 8/22/94 set remonumentation cap on iron pipe and witnessed as shown below.
