I-7, T8S, R6E, 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 13 & 24

(Temperance Road being west of Whiteford Road)

1820, G.L.O. Surveyor, Joseph Wampler, set quarter Section post at average distance in marsh with no bearing trees. 1902, Harry R. Gard survey notes set stone and witnessed to highway bridge. 1972, Case & Fleck survey recorded in Liber 622, Page 327, notes S.I.P. (set iron pipe or pin). 1976, G.B. Warnke notes iron pin. Farnham, Moores & Wirries survey recorded in Liber 730, Page 396, notes 1/2 iron bar. 1993, G.B. Warnke excavated area and set 1 inch x 8 inch capped iron pipe inside 1 1/4 inch x 24 inch iron pipe over 1/2 inch rebar.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

L-7 - 10/25/1993 - Found railroad spike at surface, excavated area and found 1/2 inch rebar 9 inches below railroad spike. Probed to a depth of 4 feet from top of pavement with no further evidence found. Twin 8 foot diameter concrete pipes to east. Most westerly pipe is approximately 12.5 feet east of rebar and 14 feet between pipes. Set 1 inch x 8 inch capped iron pipe inside 1 1/4 inch x 24 inch iron pipe over 1/2 inch rebar and witnessed as shown below. 8/23/1994, set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch black iron pipe inside monument box to replace previous points.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

L-7 - Set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch black iron pipe inside monument box to replace previous points and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and Witnesses:

North 05° West 32.04 feet nail/shiner in west face telephone pole

North 15° East 35.17 feet chisled "+" in north end 8 foot diameter concrete pipe

South 15° East 34.12 feet chisled "+" in south end 8 foot diameter concrete pipe

South 60° West 101.20 feet nail/shiner in northeast face electric pole
