A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-5, T8S, R7E, Bedford Township, Monroe County - 11) No. 58

Section Corner Common to Sections 7, 8, 17 & 18

(Erie & Secor Roads - 4" asphalt, 6" stone, dark yellow sand)

1820, G.L.O. Surveyor, Joseph Wampler, set post Cor. of Secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18: B. Oak 13 (inch) S.5°W. 95 lks. & W. Oak 16 (inch) West 95 (links). Transcribed notes from old book indicate in 1899 VanDeventer notes stone. A.J. Marino: 1949 & undated misc. records note stone; 1951 notes set R.R. spike; 1953 & 1954 notes R.R. Spike. M.R. Fleck: 1972, 1975, 1977, 1979 & 1984 notes found R.R. Spike; 1985 notes found iron; undated witness card notes iron bar. G.B. Warnke: 1976, 1978, 1979, 1985, 1987 & 1988 notes R.R. spike.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-5 - 11/17/1994, found railroad spike 4 inches below surface. Dug an 18 inch x 30 inch hole and probed in all directions; no further evidence found by railroad spike. Compared 1951 witnesses (oldest known witnesses to railroad spike) and last known witnesses to stone and found them to be a few feet different. Dug a 12 inch x 18 inch hole, approximately 3 feet southwest of railroad spike, and probed in all directions and found dark blue granite stone approximately 3.5 feet south and 0.5 feet west of railroad spike and approximately 1 foot deep. 12/2/1994, set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace found railroad spike.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C-5 - set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside mornment box to replaced railroad spike and accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the accepted corner and Witnesses:

South 40° East 49.10 feet to nail/shiner in northeast face of utility pole

South 45° West 42.16 feet to nail/shiner in north face of telephone pole

North 45° West 42.25 feet to nail/shiner in south face of telephone pole
