C-13 - On 9/29/1992, replaced stone with a capped 1/2 inch x 24 inch iron pipe (No. 19474) inside a 1 1/2 inch O.D. x $4.\tilde{2}$ foot iron pipe inside a monument box and witnessed as shown below. 12/13/1994, set 1/2 inch x 24 inch rebar with brass remonumentation cap inside existing 1/2 inch x 24 inch iron pipe.
