Oak 18 inch N.2°W. 41 links & W. Oak 17 inch S.2°W. 60 links. / Old book indicates stone, possibly by John W. VanDeventer in 1900 or Howard in 1903, County Surveyors. / 1950, A.J. Marino states a steel plug in 4 inch v.s.p. tile. / March of 1964, L.J. Czubak survey notes ackerman bolt in repaying of M-151. After repaying, M.S.H.D. Survey Chief K.M. Liubakka set boat spike in monument box and rewitnessed on 10-11-65. / Many old surveys do not state corner material. / 1972 to date, area surveyors witnessed and used iron pin or bar in standard monument hox set in present concrete pavement as corner.
