1960, Case & Fleck survey notes found iron pipe.

G.B. Warnke has used axle shaft over old iron pipe, has used for several years.

1993, F.J. Berning survey notes found iron axle.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

7/95 - G.B. Warnke & MCRC Crew dug. Found 5/8" x 30" iron rebar driven thru a 3/4" x 12" iron pipe found by M.S.I. surveyors. 1993, found 3/4" x 20" iron pipe @ 1.4' deep 0.5' south of 5/8" rebar. Dug 24" x 24" hole - in corner 1.0' south & 0.7' west. Found 1 1/4" x 10" hub standing on 6" x 7" x 13" limestone @ 30" in depth. Found 6 1/2" tall black granite 5"+/- diameter under stone. Removed stone and found coffee ground type soil which may be post but could not verify a type of post. Set 5/8" rebar over stone. 8/29/1995 - corner approved by Remonumentation Peer Group (see dossier for further information).

In 1996, MCRC crew is scheduled to perform road work in area and will set 1" x 36" iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap set inside monument box to replace rebar & stone.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" rebar over stone (to be replaced by set 1" x 36" iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box in 1996) and accept as best available evidence of the position of the original corner as submitted and witnesses:

South 48° East 53.02 feet to top nut of hydrant

South 60° West 64.13 feet to nail & car coin in northeast face of telephone & traffic light pole

North 66.58 feet to southwest corner (at wood siding) of bldg. no. 1660

North 53° East 44.02 feet to nail & shiner in southwest face of guy OF MICH CORRECTION CORNER 6.75 ft 5.00°23'19"E.
