Section Corner common to Sections 3 & 4, T9S, R7E: 1820 GLO Surveyor, Joseph Wampler, set corner post for G-13 on Township Line. 1837 GLO Surveyor, Andrew Poden intersected the Town Line and set the Post 3.65 Chains East of the Post to Section 33 & 34, T8S, R7E; (There appears to be an error in the transcribing of the Government field notes. The notes indicate 3.65 Lks East of the Post.
