C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set Remonumentation Corner over Boat Spike

- P.K. in Power Pole S45°E 52.03 feet
- P.K. in East side Power Pole S45°W 67.56 feet
- P.K. in East side Power Pole N45°E 62.59 feet
- P.K. in Top of "Head" of Curb N40°W 47.19 feet

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

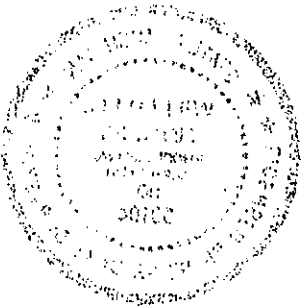
