B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 4" cast-iron monument with a county surveyor's cap flush with ground in a rock pile. The corner is on the north/south fence line and occupation line to the west. No evidence of the 1967 Consumer Power Company's corner, although, large fence post is lying down approximately 4' south of the found monument. Accepted the position of found monument due to the historical usage and documentation. Evidence is inconclusive that the corner is a true and correct perpetuation of the G.L.O. corner.
