

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Found a 1 1/2" iron rod in the centerline of East/West gravel road on old fence line to the South. Found an old Twin Cherry stump North 55° East, 42'±. Witnesses are recorded in a 1986 survey by Westshore Consulting. Position of the existing corner was accepted due to historical usage and documentation.
