A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C. F. Lewandowski set boat spike on North/South fence line on extension of C-11 and C-10. During the same 1968 survey, he set C-10, as obliterated corner, on the intersection of fence lines. Also, found iron 18' South of boat spike.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 11/4" iron boat spike, no evidence of iron 18' South of boat spike, as was documented in 1968 by C. F. Lewandowski. Retraced location of pulled iron. Evidence is conclusive that the iron 18 South of boat spike was established by G.L.O. witnesses. Set a 1/2" iron rod in the Northwest side of 12" Twin Oak with a county survey's cap. The reset position of corner is a perpetuation of original G.L.O. corner. Corner is on the North/South fence line.

18.00" Toe bank and edge of marsh (G.L.O. 16.5') N

165'± Center of Cedar Creek (G.L.O. 165') N

E 40' Toe bank - no marsh (G.L.O. 6.6' enter marsh.) Area is farmed and appears to be disturbed. Area has appearance of a blowhole that may have filled in marsh. Old bank is 150'-200' to the Southeast, lines up with 1837 G.L.O. call.

It should be noted that the prior recorded corner (1 1/4" boat spike), set in 1968, may be recognized as a property controlling corner. Recent surveys have used and relied on this prior corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 1/2" x 20" iron rod in the Northwest side of 12" Twin Oak with a county surveyor's cap. Corner on North/South fence line. 1 1/4" boat spike, recorded in L.C.R.C., Liber 1513, page 296 and L.C.R.C., Liber 2025, page 517. Ν 18.00'
