

 - (2) Muskegon County Road Commission 1920's: Found stone, replaced with 2" iron pipe
 - (3) Muskegon County Road Commission, no date, Iron rod SE 82.13' 30" Elm, SSE 55.99' 18" Elm
 - (4)D. Sandel, #25870 on 11-27-89 found iron rod: N04°E end of sewer pipe, 19.05'; S58°E Ash, 66.42'; S60°W Oak, 61.63'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 - (1) Found 1/2" X 12" well rusted iron rod 5' +/- north of centerline of Butzer Road (E/W Gravel) over centerline of concrete culvert running N/S. I believe this to be historical corner used by Ed Scharmer. Intersection of 1/4 lines would be 1.42' North of said corner. Verified corner location using existing witnesses.
