Babbitt _______ do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above (identified with circles on index code diagram—over) were, in a field survey on _______ 1981, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered or restored as expressed below and in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a court of law. Furthermore, that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were, in a field survey on _______ 19___, found, recovered, restored, established or re-established as expressed below and in conformance with the rules of the Michigan State Board of Registration for Land Surveyors or, by a Decree of a Court of law:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- K-9 S.W. corner of Section 24; Wood Post, Cedar 26" $N41^{\circ}W$ 33 lks.; DO 30" $S21^{\circ}E$ 22 lks.
- L-9 South 1/4 corner of Section 24; Cedar Post Tam. $18'' N44^{\circ}W 30$ lks., Cedar $10'' S25^{\circ}E 28$ lks.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

- K-9 Set by double proportion using 1/4 corners, 1/2 mile north, 1/2 mile east and 1/2 mile south and the section corner 1 mile west. No sign of O.B.T.s.
- L-9 Set from 20" Tam. Stump N44°W 30 lks. Too rotten and weathered for marks, but it is the only Tam. Stp. of proper size within reasonable distance and there are fragments of a cedar in the approx. position for the S.E. O.B.T. Swamp calls 1-1/2 chs. west and 9 chs. east fit very well, and is only 7.5' from a proportioned position. Also using this position, a large cedar with line blazes on the E. and W. sides, falls on line less than 100' E. By counting the growth rings this cedar was determined to have been marked between 1900 and 1910 accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- K-9 <u>1" pipe, 4" aluminum cap; 4" Spruce N45°E 30.0'; 9" Balsam S50°E 26.4'; 5" Spruce S73°W 20.8'; 6" Spruce N3°W 13.5'.</u>
- L-9 <u>1" pipe, 4" aluminum cap</u>; 14" Cedar N10°W 16.25'; 10" Cedar N68°E 10.8'; 5" Cedar S27°W 4.0'; 4" Cedar N64°W 22.3'.
