- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- K-7. Found 3/4" pipe with both Marquette County Road Comm. witnesses in place but both are dead. This corner was not substantiated by original survey evidence but if there was a "very old cedar post" there in 1948, it seems reasonable to think that it dates back at least to the 1920's. The original survey record calls for leave swamp at 6.50 chs. enter swamp at 10:00 chs and stream 6 lks. at 12.57 going east from this cor. It calls for "1/2 acre of dry ground" at 7.73 chains south from this cor. and going north it calls for leaving the swamp at 2.00 chains. These feature calls all agree well with this location and since this location has apparently been accepted as the section corner for at least 60 to 80 years, I see no reason to dispute it. I have, therefore, rewitnessed the pipe as found.
- L-9. Found 3/4" pipe with both Marquette Co. Rd. Commission wits in place but the maple is dead. Re-witnessed as found.
