

1962: A Michigan Department of Conservation Land Comer Record by Amie A. Metsa, not recorded, indicates the corner as a 2" Iron Pipe w/ coupling attached to end. This corner was set from original tamarack B.T.'s probably by mining company surveyors apparently 40 to 50 years ago. Set new bearing trees after checking the pipe for accuracy with the original B.T's. The Tamarack 14 S81E 32 links was a 4-foot shattered stub, but had both faces plain and scribe marks very distinct on upper face. The other tamarack B.T's were low, rounded stumps with all evidence of scribe marks and faces gone. All B.T.'s, however, checked well for bearing and distances to pipe.
