DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO NOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This corner was set from the original homlock bearing tree. The homlock had fallon with the face down, but sending off the butt and relling over the section uncovered the face. The scribe marks showed very plainly. The rotted stump of the opruce bearing tree was evident. An old birch tree about 6 feet from the corner location had been marked for the corner. There was no post in evidence at this corner. Gerner was set by A. Notes and W. Oliver.
