I. Paul R. Bressette in a field survey on \_\_\_\_ August do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 6. 1909: C. Cummings, Co. Surveyor. Gives proportioned distances for west line of Section 6. No mention of monuments or witnesses.
- Section corner common to Sections 1,12,6 and 7. 1909: C. Cummings, Co. Surveyor. Gives proportioned distances for west line of Section 6. No mention of monuments or witnesses. A-3.
- South One-sixteenth corner common to Sections 1 and 6. Not set in original survey, no 10. evidence of subsequent establishment.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- No evidence of original survey or restoration found. Corner position re-established by single proportionate measurement between the Northwest and Southwest corners of Section 6. A-2. Corner falls at angle point of a power line and falls on the east and south edges of the right of way clearing.
- Found  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin and two witnesses. It has been used in the survey of the power line and is similar to the iron pin found 1 mile north. Accepted found iron pin and set DNR monument A-3. beside it. The found witnesses were cut down during power line clearing and construction. Distance to north is 34.8 feet short of Cummings proportioned distances.
- 10. Corner position established mid-point and on-line between the Southwest and West Quarter corners of Section 6. Corner falls on east edge of power line clearing and was placed in a mound of stones. Tower pole witness is stamped "18335" and "167L 30-85 1000". Distance is measured to face of pole.
