Babbitt, P.S.#21558, of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources-District 3-Region-1 office states: "At the NW section corner there is a 1" pipe driven in about 29' north of the centerline of a blacktopped county road. This pipe is recorded as "found 1" iron pipe" in Liber 4, Page 37 of Land Corner Records. The origin of said pipe is unknown. There is also what appears to be a re-rod driven in the blacktop just north of the centerline of said county road. This point seems to match the location of the section corner as indicated in the Marquette County Road Commission records and also of the G.A. Shadko access site survey. Mr. Shadko describes the section corner as "iron pin in rd." and notes two witnesses to it but his witnesses could not be found. The iron pin in the blacktop has been used as the section comer in surveys by Gourdie Frasier and Associates, Inc. and by Bill Robey L.S..
