1948: A survey plat of Big Shag Lake fishing site no. 52-1 in Section 25, T45N-R26W by G.A. Shadko, indicates the corner is an iron pin stamped 1/4 cor. by Cummings, distance N01-44-34E, 2639.6' to an iron pin in the road at the Northeast section corner and S00-48-48W, 2639.4' to an iron pin 2" square on top, 37' West from fence corner at the Southeast section corner by Cummings. No references given.

Date Unknown: A section breakdown sketch and witness sheet by Gourdie Frasier and Associates, indicate the corner is a set 1 3/4" outside diameter iron pipe with R.L.S. cap in trail with the following references:

Balsam N55W. 18.02 6" Balsam NO2W. 20.581 7" Balsam 2" N81E, 21.07 13.26 Sq. I. Pin N42W.

1977: A Certificate of Survey by Gourdie Frasier and Associates Inc., P.S.#17618 L.327 SM, Pg. 695, indicates the corner is a 1 3/4" outside diameter iron pipe with cap referenced by:

Balsam N55W. 18.02 6" Balsam NO2W. 20.581 Balsam N81E, 21,07

1980: An LCRC by Glenn Van Neste P.S.#27464, indicates that a 1 3/4" iron pipe with R.L.S. cap#17618 was set in a trail in a old depression. Location verified by local resident who had seen a grader operator scrape out old 2" sq. iron pin then reset it on the edge of the road.

1982: A Certificate of Survey by Sundberg, Carlson and Associates, Inc., P.S.#24589, in L. 001 SM, Pg. 436, indicates the corner as a found 1 3/4" iron pipe with R.L.S. cap #17618 distance S00-19-36E, 2638.54' to found 1" square iron peg 18" in height at the Southwest corner of Section 30.

1986: A Certificate of Survey by Charles F. Clark, P.S.#25836, indicates the corner as a 1 1/4" capped iron pipe(R.L.S.#17618) distance NO1-35-32E, 2639.66' to a 3/4" iron pin at the Northwest corner of Section 30.

1986: A Minutes of Survey prepared by David B. Babbitt, P.S. #21558, of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources-District 3-Region-1 office states:"At the West 1/4 corner the corner of record is a 1-3/4" iron pipe with RLS cap but there is also a 2" square iron set in conc. N42W-13,26' from said pipe. The square iron is marked 1/4 corner and appears to be of the same origin as the monument at the SW section corner which is reputed to be part of a Cummings survey although I did not find a record of such Cummings survey. The recordation certificate at Liber 4-Page 37 states that a local resident saw a grader scrape out the square iron and reset it on the edge of the road (a logging road). I found this very hard to believe in view of the fact that this square iron is set in concrete and appears to be very solidly in place. However, after retracing a survey for the public access site on Big Shag Lake done by G.A. Shadko in 1948 I must conclude that the sq. iron has, in fact, been moved. Shadko's survey describes the 1/4 cor. As " I Pin stamped 1/4 cor (Cummings)". A retracement of Shadko's survey places the 1/4 cor. At the location of the 1-3/4" pipe and RLS cap and does not fit the present location of the square topped iron stamped "1/4 cor.". I have, therefore, accepted the 1-3/4" pipe and RLS cap as the West 1/4 corner of Section 30."
