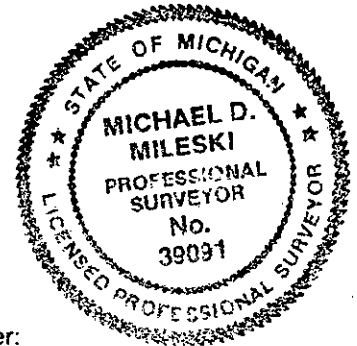

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-2; West One-Quarter Corner Section 2;

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I-2; West One-Quarter Section 2;

Found 1" iron pipe consistent in form to previously recovered M.C.R.C. monumentation. Found no evidence of U.S. or M.C.R.C. accessories. Monument is within 3 feet of the M.C.R.C.'s intended position.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I-2; West One-Quarter Section 2;

Set 2" I.D. x 30" aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap (Berntsen A1NB30) appropriately stamped as to location.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-2; West One-Quarter Corner Section 2;

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by Martin Hall, D.S. in 1852 and monumented with a spruce pine post witnessed by a Spruce Pine 12 S53°W 37 lks. and a Spruce Pine 12 N67°E 31 lks.

This corner was remonumented with a 1" iron pipe and jack pine post on 16 December 1941 by the Marquette County Road Commission at a position intended to be perpendicular to the north township line at a distance of 2702.7 feet from the northwest corner of section 2. Marquette County Road Commission field notes indicate that the west line of section 2 so determined would be parallel to the east line of section 1. Refer to M.C.R.C. field book 712 pages 9 & 10.

Since the M.C.R.C. remonumented the southwest corner of section 2 on the same line at record U.S. distance from the northwest corner of section, it is probable that they intended to remonument the west one-quarter corner of section 2 at record U.S. distance (40.91 chains - 2700.06 feet) from the northwest corner of section 2. The record U.S. distance for the entire west line of section 2 is 80.95 chains. The M.C.R.C. distance of 2702.7 feet may arise from the incorrect determination of the length of the north one-half of the west line of section 2 as $80.95 \text{ ch} - 40.00 \text{ ch} = 40.95 \text{ ch} = 2702.7 \text{ feet}$.

However, record U.S. distance for the south one-half mile of the west line of section 2 is 40.04 chains.

The M.C.R.C. noted the following new bearing trees:

- 4" Jack Pine N32°W 23.0'
- 4" Jack Pine S16°E 13.1'
