DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Found a 2"x36" iron pipe with 2" brass identification cap in place as set by Robert W. Livingston, General Land Office Surveyor, in September 1929. Corner had been perpetuated in 1929 from the original BT's in the course of a G.L.O. survey of islands in nearby lakes. I confirmed that the monument is undisturbed from two of Livingston's 1929 NBT's, a Maple 11 N38°30'W 38 lks. and a Y. Birch 8 S35° 30'E 56 links, the former now a 21 inch tree and the latter a 12 inch tree. (Refer to G.L.O.
