- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found monument as described, the NW NBT dead but standing, and a stump in position for SE NBT. Accepted monument as found and rewitnessed. Corner is south of a trail road in the southeast corner of a clearcut. The gate post is 8" x 6" oak.

(M8) Found monument as described, the SN NBT is a blow down, and the remaining NBT's have been cut. Accepted monument as found and rewitnessed.
