- Found 2" iron pipe and witnesses as described in L. 1, p.599, Survey maps. Replaced found pipe with DNR monument and blazed upper and lower faces on NBTs. Measurements to notch in lower face.
- A-10. Found 1" iron pipe, tamarack stub NE with axe marks and tamarack stump NW in proper position for OBTs. Excavation at pipe revealed 3 stake points, one considerably older than others. Set DNR monument at point of old stake.
- C-10. No evidence of OBTs or subsequent reestablishment found. Corner reestablished midpoint and on line between the northeast and southeast corners of Section 30.
