B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

B-5: 1996: Found and accepted a 1/2" Iron with Yellow Cap (top missing), flush with paved road surface, +/- 5.2' South of North edge of asphalt pavement. Checked Line Call: East 3.0 Chains (198'), Foot of Hill, Enter Swamp. Measured Call: East, 198', call does not fit as there is swamp extending East and West on North side of road (altered residential area South of road). Checked Line Call: East, 6.75 Chains (445.5') Leave Swamp. Measured Call: East, 445', call fits well as one leaves lowland area and observes a noticeable change in vegetation on North side of road. Checked Line Call: West, 3.0 Chains (198'), Ascend Hill Gradual. Measured Call: West, 198', call does not appear to fit as we encountered swamp to North of road and a low rise to South of road at this distance. The toe of a gradual hill can be observed +/- 550' to the West along the road. Distance and bearing to found reference checks well with those recorded by Joseph Wasie in 1981. Distance East is 2657.26' and Distance West is 2735.98'.
