No Date: The corner is shown on an unidentified map recorded Corner was monumented by Cleveland-Cliffs in the early in L. 109, MR Pg. 168. 1900's. Checks with old Corord data on corner. References: 1977: A Certificate of Survey recorded by Joseph O. Wasie 6" Poplar S65W, 5.1' 6" Spruce S02W, 18.0' RLS #15415 in L. 325, Deeds Pg. 500, indicates the corner as 8" W. Birch NO2E, 53.5' 10" W. Birch S02E, 49.5" found iron rail referenced by:

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: 1995: Found and accepted a railroad rail with punch mark in small pile of rocks, 0.90' above ground. Distance North is 2571.58' and Distance South is 2630.65'. RATIFIED BY PEER GROUP C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: 1995: Ishpeming Township welders welded a 3/4" X 7" rebar on top of found rail, and we capped it with a 3 1/4" aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument , 0.62' above the rail and 1.5' above the ground, and stamped to identify the corner. Punched a "+" mark in the correct corner position on the aluminum tablet, and blotted out the ready made punch mark found at the center of the tablet.
