Distance North is 2628.87', Distance East is 2605.66', and Distance West to found East 1/16 Corner to Sections 5 and 8 is 1316.32'. RATIFIED BY PEER GROUP Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: 1995: Offset and removed found 5/8" iron, finding a 2" O.D. pipe 20" below grade and leaning in a Southerly direction. Offsets to found 5/8" iron matched the center of found pipe, so we drove a 3/4" X 36" iron along the South side of pipe and heated and bent it to match offset distances. Capped iron with a 3 1/4" aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument, 6" below grade in a set cast iron monument box, and stamped to identify the corner. Established references: N36E, 86.64' 3" Balsam N53E, 68.47' 17" R. Pine 4" Tamarack N82E. 112.62' S65W. 166.281 Green Steel Sign Post w/Survey Marker Sign East. 37.0' ENote: Checked witnesses of record (Bussone, 1989, L. 5, RC Pg. 193), and distances to each checked exactly except for a 5" Poplar, for which only a stump remained.
