1995: Found Cummings Iron Mushroom leaning North, and not in original position. Dug the 6.5' long Cummings monument out and re-positioned to Cummings original location. The monument ended up slightly tilted to the North because the pipe is bent and couldn't be straightened. The center of the monument is in the same location as 1 1/4" X 1 1/4" square top iron which was set by CCI surveyors at the point where the mushroom monument straightened out below the ground. The mushroom monument was apparently bent to the North by heavy equipment. Distance North is 2614.36' and Distance South is 2634.23'.
