No evidence of original B.T.'s could be found. An original GLO line call to the Barnhardt Creek measures 824' (891'R) southerly from this point. Witnesses recorded in LCRC L.4, P.162 have been destroyed. A thorough search found no evidence of any other survey monumentation or occupation in the immediate area. The position of the corner has been used and accepted by others as evidenced by line markings. All measurements, obtainable recorded survey information and any other obtained unrecorded survey information made available to Spalding DeDecker Associates is documented in the research dossier. Considering the above information, all known evidence favors the correctness of this point.
