This corner was set by R. Jamros, P.S. No. 25849 while surveying for Benson Forests. The corner was set on line between the S.W. and N.W. Corners of Section 34 and the proportioned distance between the GLO Calls for C/L Stream and Summit of Ridge. The GLO Distance between calls was 2471.04' and measured was 2475.19', a difference of 4.15'.
