I, GERALD W. CARLSON, in a field survey on DECEMBER 16TH, 1996, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 F-9: Quarter Corner common to Sections 21 and 28.
 1845: Sam U. Hill's original subdivision survey notes describe the corner monument as a wood post referenced by:
 18" Sugar S08W, 80 L 14" Sugar N18W, 30 L

No Date: A map of the Proposed Negaunee Airport (Source unknown) indicates the corner as an old Iron Monument, and shows a fence running North from the corner. Distance N87-25'E, 2635.2' to the N.E. Corner of Section 28; Distance S00-08'W, 2558.4' to the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 28; and Distance N00-19'W, 1332.4' to the Center-South 1/16 Corner of Section 21. No accessories given.

1910: A Survey Map of Section 28 by R.A. Brotherton for C.C.I. Co. indicates a set Iron at the corner. Distance South, 2564.34' to the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 28. No accessories given.

1910: A sketch of Section 28 by R.A. Brotherton for C.C.I. Co. indicates the corner as having been previously set. Distance East, 2638.8' to the N.E. Corner of Section 28. Distance South, 2564.34' to an Iron set by R.A. Brotherton at the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 28. No accessories given.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 F-9: 1996: Searched and found no original or subsequent corner evidence. Obtained coordinate values of this corner and the corners 1/2 mile East, West, and South from Larry Bussone, P.S. #25833, who tied in these corners by traverse some years ago. The corners 1/2 mile East, West, and South are still in existence, and the Distances checked well with those by Bussone. We used our Star-Net adjustment program to obtain a "best fit" location of this corner from the other three known corners. The final distances checked very well with those previously determined by Bussone. Distance East is 2635.67' and Distance West is 2656.13'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
 F-9: 1996: Set a 2 3/8" O.D. aluminum pipe capped with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument stamped to identify the corner. Monument is 0.6' below ground. Referenced by:
 S.E.'LY Fence Corner Due North, 259.34' Tenth Fence Post West of S.E.'LY Fence Corner N20W, 271.15'
 N.W. Corner Black Sign #3 S36W, 274.63' Runway Light #49 S30W, 274.10'
 Green Steel Sign Post w/ Yellow Survey Marker Sign Due North, 2.0'

1933: Field notes from MCRC F.B. #116 (No page given) indicate the corner as a 1 1/2" diameter Iron Pipe at fence corner. Fence runs North and West. Page at the back of F.B. #166 indicates a Distance N87-24' + E, 2638.3' to the N.E. Corner of Section 28. Distance S00-08'W, 2558.3' to the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 28. No accessories given.

No Date: Field notes from MCRC F.B. #701 (No page given) indicate the corner as a 1" Iron Pipe at fence intersection. No accessories given.

1941: A Field Map of Section 21 by R.A. Brotherton for C.C.I. Co. indicates the corner as an Iron. No accessories given.

1968: A sketch of Section 28 from the personal notes of R.A. Brotherton, as copied in 1968 by R.J. Brotherton, indicate the corner as an Iron - B.T. on Pine. Distance East, 2639.47' to the N.E. Corner of Section 28; Distance West, 2674.0' to the N.W. Corner of Section 28; and Distance South, 2564.34' to the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 28. No accessories given.

1978: Survey field notes from C.C.I. indicate they tied into a found Iron at the North 1/4 Corner of Section 28. Distance S88-22'-34"W, 2656.00' to the N.W. Corner of Section 28, and N87-15'-14"E, 2635.46' to the N.E. Corner of Section 28. No accessories given.
