1993 - No originial evidence of B.T.'s was found at corner location. G.L.O. line calls can't substantiate placement. This corner was set on a proportion between the West 1/4 corner of Section 19 of the NW corner of Section 18. Using the proportioned position, the South 1/4 corner of Section 19 has only a 2 minute deflection on the South line of Section 18 to the pro rated corner. G.L.O. calls on the West line of Section 18 to pro rated corner check well, the general bearing of the range line checks well, G.L.O. tie to the Dead River North of the SW corner of Section 18 fits within 7 feet. Peer group ratification 11-29-93.
