No evidence of original B.T.'s could b found. An original GLO line call to the Barnhardt Creek measures 824' (891'R) southerly from this point. Witnesse recorded in LCRC L.4, P.162 have been destroyed. A thorough search found no evidence of any other survey monumentatio or occupation in the immediate area. The position of the corner has been used and accepted by others as evidenced b line markings. All measurements, obtainable recorded survey information and any other obtained unrecorded survey. information made available to Spalding DeDecker Associates is documented in the research dossier. Considering the abov information, all known evidence favors the correctness of this point.
