B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:


Found 1" iron as described in unrecorded survey by Larry Bussone, PS 25833. This corner was re-established from remains of the original 10" Spruce B.T. and a line call to the edge of a swamp at 40.50 chains. A thorough search found no evidence of any other monumentation or occupation in the immediate area. All measurements, obtainable recorded survey information and any other obtained unrecorded survey information made available to Spalding DeDecker Associates is documented in the research dossier. Considering the above information, all known evidence favors accepting the position of this point.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced 1" iron bar with standard Marquette County Remonumentation Monument, being a 2 3/8" diameter x 30" aluming post with 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap stamped with appropriate corner identification and "MCR 1998, PLATZ 38121". aluminum the following new witnesses:
