Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Brass Tablet on 2" diameter galvanized pipe, 3.6' above ground. Accepted Brass Cap as found. Distance South is 2612.61'. In 1918 both B.T.'s were standing when CCI set the brass cap. In 1945 the M.C.R.C. had only 1 B.T. to work from, therefore it was determined that CCI would have set the corner in the correct position by crossing both distances. A variation in the Bearings of the B.T.'s is the probable reason that the M.C.R.C. position fell 11.7' East of the brass capped pipe.
